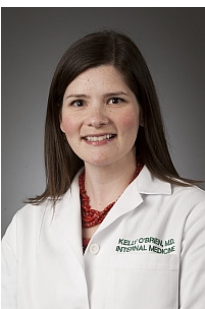
Thomas R. Lux, M.D.

M. Yesim Ersoy, M.D.

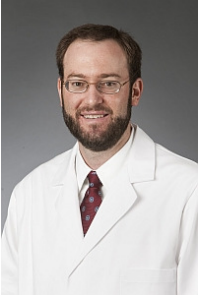
